

Tournament Rules

Teams in each group will play each other as per the draw and score 2 points for a win, 1 point for a draw and 0 for a defeat.

If there is a tie in points after the group matches the winners will be team that has the highest score the following criteria (in order):-

1. Most tries scored in all group matches
2. Try difference in all group matches
3. Play off for 5mins each way
4. Play until decisive try scored

Team/squad sizes

Primary 3 **6** players from squad of 10
Primary 4-6 **8** players from squad of 12
Primary 7 **10** players from squad of 14

Game lengths

Primary 3 10 mins total (5 min halves)
Primary 4 - 5 14 mins total (7 min halves)
Primary 6 - 7 20 mins total (10 min halves)

Game Rules

Current SRU mini-rugby rules will be in operation (in summary):-

All tackles below waist; No targeting the ball;

Tackled player must pass, play or release;

No hand-offs, ball carried in 2 hands.

P3-6 tap and pass from touch.

P7 uncontested line-outs, scrum half pass.

P6-7 scrums, uncontested drive but hookers may strike, scrum half must pass.

P6 scrum 3 front row

P7 scrum 3 front row, 2 back row

P3-5 no kicking

P6-7 clearance kicks within 5M of goal line

Code for Spectators

Acknowledge and respect good performance by both teams.
